


Product Consistency Practice Sheet




Product ball on tip of brush should have the **texture** and **look** of a **pearl**, and be slightly rounded.


IF NOT: CLEAN your **Brush** & get a new ball.




- #1 Ball - Free-Edge
- larger ball - wet
 - Pat from one side of nail groove to the other



- #2 Ball - 1/2 of Nail Body
- smaller ball - wetter
 - apply like nail polish
 - STROKE ALL THE WAY OVER THE FREE-EDGE




- #3 Ball - Cuticle Area
- smaller ball - wetter
 - apply like nail polish leaving 1/32" space around cuticle
 - STROKE




- #4 Ball - Stress Area
- smallest ball - wettest
 - apply between 2 & 3 balls
 - smooth over entire nail, building up stress area and smoothing nail

Note: Take notice of the **BRUSH Angles**, when applying your balls.



Note: **Dip** brush into liquid, all the way to base of brush. If you want a small ball, drain more liquid from your brush. If you want a large ball, drain less liquid. To drain, **wipe** one side of the brush away from you, then **drag** tip of brush towards you across powder, until you see the right size ball. **Drag** brush **lightly** for **smaller balls** or drag **deeper** for **larger balls**.



- 12 Steps**
- Sanitize
 - Remove Polish
 - Etch
 - Dust
 - Prime
 - Apply Forms
 - Re-Prime
 - Apply Product
 - File
 - Buff
 - Wash Hands
 - Polish
